Thank you for your questions.

This looks like an Austin 7 four seat tourer commonly called a 'Chummy'

It appears to have 7" brakes and the Headlights on the scuttle which would indicate 1928 .

The vertical windscreen is not usual for an Australian made body.

With two adults and two children the standard Chummy would tour at 30-35 miles per hour with a maximum speed of 40-45 mph.

The regular cable brakes - foot-brake on the rear wheels and handbrake on the front were only just adequate at these speeds in early traffic.
